STARTS SEPT 1, 2021**

Community groups that use single-use plastic items as part of community or fundraising activities **may be affected by the ban**. This forum series will provide information for these groups to **become ban compliant**.

 

Single-Use Plastic Ban in Queensland: **Information Session Monday 19th July**

The Queensland government is about to ban some single use plastics in Queensland. **From 1st September 2021** certain single-use plastic items will be banned including plastic straws, stirrers, cutlery, plates, bowls and expanded polystyrene cups and containers.

The planned Information Session **in Townsville on Monday 19th July from 5.30-6.30pm** will be particularly good for restaurateurs, community, and event organisers, so come along to learn more, and feel free to invite your friends and contacts to come as well.
